Compton Man Admits Killing Stepfather and Stepsister

A Compton man has pleaded guilty to killing his 65-year-old stepfather and his 13-year-old stepsister, the Los Angeles County District Attorney's Office announced today.

Jamie Jajuan Williams, 44, of Compton entered the plea yesterday to two counts of murder with a special circumstance allegation of multiple murders and one count of attempted murder.

Deputy District Attorney Cynthia Wallace said Williams also admitted allegations of use of a handgun and causing great bodily injury to the victim of the attempted murder.

Sentencing is scheduled on February 20 in Department K of the Los Angeles County Superior Court, Compton Branch. Williams faces life in prison without the possibility of parole as a result of the plea.

On Sept. 28, 2018, the defendant shot his stepfather, Eddie Charles Talley Jr., his stepsister, Brittany M., and her mother, the prosecutor said. Talley Jr. and Brittany M. died as a result of the shooting, the prosecutor added.

Case TA147171 was investigated by the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department.
