Former Workers at LAX Sentenced in Dry Ice Explosion Case

Two men charged in connection with two dry ice explosions at Los Angeles International Airport were sentenced today, the Los Angeles County District Attorney's Office announced.

Deputy District Attorney Sean Carney of the Target Crimes Division said Dicarlo Bennett, 29, and Miguel Angel Iñiguez, 41, each pleaded no contest today to one felony count of possession of a destructive device.

Judge James Dabney of the Los Angeles County Superior Court, Airport Branch, sentenced both defendants to three years probation and 480 hours of community service.

Bennett and Iñiguez, who both worked for an airport service company, placed three explosive devices near the LAX terminals on Oct. 13, 2013, Carney said. Two of the devices exploded, the third one did not detonate.

The case was investigated by the Los Angeles Police Department.
