## **Former Volleyball Coach Sentenced to Prison for Sex Crimes Against Two Students**

A former volleyball coach at an East Los Angeles high school was sentenced today to prison for sex crimes against two students, the Los Angeles County District Attorney's Office announced.

Los Angeles County Superior Court Judge Robert Vanderet sentenced Jonathan Adam Roldan, 24, to three years in state prison and imposed a 10-year criminal protective order. Roldan also must register as a sex offender for life.

The case was prosecuted by Deputy District Attorney Reinhold Mueller of the Sex Crimes Division. Roldan pleaded no contest on March 11 to one felony count of unlawful sexual intercourse with a minor under 16 and child molesting, a misdemeanor.

Roldan, a former junior varsity girls volleyball coach at Esteban Torres High School, sexually abused two female students between September and November 2013.

Roldan engaged in a sexual relationship with one student while also "dating" a second student. Both victims were 15 years old at the time of the offenses.

The case was investigated by the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department, Special Victims Bureau.
