**Harbor City Registered Sex Offender  
Sentenced for Lewd Acts with Teens**

A Harbor City man entered a no contest plea today for having sex with two teenage girls, the Los Angeles County District Attorney's Office announced.

Deputy District Attorney Delanee Hicks said Hugo Galindo González, 27, pleaded no contest to two felony counts of lewd acts upon a child in case YA090010.

Los Angeles County Superior Court Judge Thomas Sokolov immediately sentenced González to three years and eight months in state prison.

González also was ordered to register as a sex offender for life.

The defendant was already registered as a sex offender as a result of a 2011 conviction in Federal Court.

González met the two victims in the current case, ages 14 and 15, online in January. He provided alcohol for the girls before having sex with them, the prosecutor said.

The case was investigated by the Redondo Beach Police Department.
