San Diego Man Charged with Mayhem for Rose Bowl Concert Fight

A 25-year-old San Diego man was charged today with mayhem and two other counts after a confrontation at the Jay Z and Beyoncé concert at the Rose Bowl in Pasadena this weekend, the Los Angeles County District Attorney's Office announced.

Roberto Alcaraz Garnica (dob 7/31/89) was charged with one felony count each of mayhem and battery with serious bodily injury and one misdemeanor count of battery in case GA094155.

Arraignment is scheduled this afternoon in Department D of the Los Angeles County Superior Court, Pasadena Branch.

On Aug. 2, Garnica pushed a woman at the concert into some chairs, prosecutors said. When the woman's husband confronted the defendant he punched the husband and a fight ensued, the prosecutor added. During the fight Garnica allegedly bit the tip of the male victim's left index finger off completely.

Prosecutors are recommending bail be set at \$100,000. If convicted as charged, he faces eight years in state prison.

The case is being investigated by the Pasadena Police Department.
