**New Charges Filed in South Pasadena
Alleged School Shooting Plot**

A juvenile delinquency petition has been amended to add conspiracy charges against two teens who allegedly planned a shooting at South Pasadena High School, the Los Angeles County District Attorney's Office announced.

The boys, ages 16 and 17 (dob 12/11/97 and 12/11/96), are now facing one count each of conspiracy to commit murder, conspiracy to commit assault with a deadly weapon and making criminal threats in case GJ30964 and GJ30402.

The new charges, filed yesterday, pertain to a school shooting plot at South Pasadena High School. The petition alleges the conspiracy took place between Sept. 1, 2013 and Aug. 16, 2014.

The teens also are accused of sharing their intent with another teen. On Aug. 16, the juveniles threatened to kill the teen, prosecutors said.

Both teens denied the new charges and are scheduled to return to court Sept. 23. A trial date has been set for Sept. 25.

The case remains under investigation by the South Pasadena Police Department.
