San Pedro Man Charged with 2006 Murder of Estranged Wife

A 41-year-old man was charged today with the murder of his estranged wife 13 years ago, the Los Angeles County District Attorney's Office announced.

Carl Dennis Mayes (dob 12/16/77) of San Pedro faces one count each of murder and possession of a firearm by a felon.

Case NA112863 includes allegations that Mayes personally and intentionally used a handgun causing great bodily injury or death. $\,$

Arraignment is scheduled today in Department So1 of the Los Angeles County Superior Court, Long Beach Branch.

On July 14, 2006, Mayes allegedly killed Tyquesha Myers, 20, and a day later reported her missing, prosecutors said. Her body was found that day alongside the 710 Freeway in Long Beach, prosecutors added.

Mayes faces a possible maximum sentence of more than 50 years to life in state prison if convicted as charged. Bail is scheduled at more than \$3 million.

The case remains under investigation by the Long Beach Police Department.
