**Man Sentenced to Prison for
Killing Stepfather on Christmas Day**

A 22-year-old man convicted of stabbing his stepfather to death last Christmas was sentenced to 16 years to life in state prison, the Los Angeles County District Attorney's Office announced.

Rudy Flores of Los Angeles pleaded guilty on Sept. 10 to one count of second-degree murder in case TA131365. The defendant also admitted to a special allegation of personally using a deadly weapon, a knife, in the commission of the crime.

Deputy District Attorney R.J. Dreiling, who prosecuted the case, said on Dec. 25, 2013, Flores had been arguing with his mother about a baseball bat she hid from him.

The mother refused to tell Flores where it was located and then entered her bedroom.

As she closed the bedroom door, Flores pushed his way in and stabbed his stepfather, Nery Ambrosio, 54, who was in the room.

After the attack, a family member called 911 and authorities arrested Flores in connection with the killing.

The case was investigated by the Los Angeles Police Department.
