Ex-Motel Desk Clerk Pleads in Sex Trafficking Case

A man has pleaded no contest for his role in sex trafficking at a Pomona motel where he worked, the Los Angeles County District Attorney's Office announced today.

Ravirajsihn Zala (dob 7/8/95) entered his plea yesterday to one count of human trafficking of a minor for a commercial sex act. He was immediately sentenced to 18 days in county jail, placed on formal probation for five years, perform 60 hours of community service and register for life as a sex offender.

Deputy District Attorney Trudi White-Black of the Human Sex Trafficking Section, Sex Crimes Division, prosecuted the case.

Between August and September 2018, Zala rented rooms to sex workers at a Pomona motel and demanded a portion of their earnings from their commercial sex transactions.

Case KA119444 was investigated by the District Attorney's Bureau of Investigation.
